How to Prevent Being a Victim

(program highlights from Friday, Nov. 20)

- Don't Get Tazed
- Carry your purse on the shoulder closest to the building
- Never carry your purse around your neck
- When parking your vehicle, pay attention to vehicles in the area that are running and vehicles that have defrosted windows
- Never park in between two large vehicles
- If attacked in a parking lot, throw your keys under a car
- Have your keys ready when you go to the car
- If carrying pepper spray, know how to use it
- When you get your car started, don't just sit there
- If your vehicle breaks down call for help, don't accept help from a “kind” person
- Don't carry all your credit cards
- Carry \$20 in a separate pocket, if attacked give them the \$20
- When entering a public bathroom pay close attention
- Make eye contact with people in the elevator
- If someone gives you an uneasy feeling go with your gut
- Look at people, know how to identify them
- Don't store valuables in your car
- Ask the store for a security escort if you are nervous
