Ohio Safety Congress & Expo Scheduled for IX Center in Cleveland

The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation encourages employers to sign up early for the Ohio Safety Congress & Expo 2007, scheduled for March 20-22 at the IX Center in Cleveland. Registration began January 1 at www.ohiobwc.com. Employers may register at the website, by telephone at 1-800-OHIOBWC, by fax or mail. It is free to Ohio employers and this year's congress has several new speakers.

The speakers include Rusty Wallace, former NASCAR driver and ESPN racing analyst, who will be the keynote speaker. General session speakers include: Robyn Benincasa, a San Diego firefighter and multi-sport expedition racer talking about the lessons of teamwork and "battling fires" at work; David Hart, a parachutist, motivational speaker and former Army Ranger, addressing how to limit risk in dangerous work environments and on motivating a team to take safety seriously and Edwin Foulke, the assistant secretary of labor, who will provide an update on OSHA standards. This is one of the largest national events focusing on workplace safety.
