Safety Council Discount Program Eligibility Requirements for FY 2008

In addition to the educational and networking benefits of membership in the Lake County Safety Council, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation has announced it will continue the safety incentive program. Employers can earn a 2-percent discount for meeting the eligibility requirements **AND** a 2-percent **performance** bonus for reducing either frequency or severity by 10 percent.

The requirements of the discount incentive program are:

- ▶ Enroll in a local safety council by July 31, 2007
- ▶ Attend 10 meetings or events between July 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008

Safety Council Discount Program Eligibility Requirements for Fiscal Year 2008

From Eligibility Requirements, Page 1

- ▶ Company CEO must attend any one safety council sponsored function or meeting
- ▶ Submit semi-annual reports for 2007 calendar year

Employers meeting these participation eligibility requirements will receive a refund of 2 percent on their annual premium. The discount offer excludes self-insuring employers and state organizations.

Employers must have active coverage status and no outstanding BWC balance to qualify. Employers who meet the participation requirements will be eligible for the 2 percent **performance** bonus. The BWC will calculate the performance bonus based on claims data.
