LCSC Training Sessions

The Lake County Safety Council is offering two
training sessions one in June, the other in October.

The June session, “Principles of Machine
Safeguarding” is on Monday, June 8 from 8 a.m. to
4:30 p.m. It will be held at the Lake County
Department of Utilities Learning and Business
Center, 1981 Blasé Nemeth Road, Painesville.

Registration and pre-payment required. Register on
line at www.councilnews.org. The cost of the course
is \$125 for LCSC members, \$165 for non-members.

After completing the course those attending will be
able to identify types of machine motion, understand
basic guarding requirements, implement safeguards
to machine hazards using guarding and device
applications and communicate safeguards and
machine hazards to employees through training.

The second program is “Accident Investigation
Training” and it will be held on Tuesday, October 6.
This class also is at the Learning and Business
Center and runs from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Registration
and pre-payment are required. The cost is \$250 for
members and \$280 for non-members. Session
attendees will learn to conduct a thorough accident
investigation, determine root causes of accidents,
develop corrective actions and reduce accident rates
