LCSC Training Session

The Lake County Safety Council is offering
special training sessions in October.

The first program, "Accident Investigation
Training" on Tuesday, October 6 from 8 to 11:30
a.m., will be held at the Lake County Department of
Utilities Learning and Business Center. Registration

accident investigation, determine root causes of
accidents, develop corrective actions and reduce
