### **BWC News—August 2009**

The BWC Board of Directors continues to enhance the agencies rate reform efforts. At its July meeting the board voted to further strengthen the requirements for group sponsors.

Group sponsors provide services to employers who qualify for group discounts. The new requirements will give the BWC greater opportunities to ensure sponsor associations and their affiliates market their services accurately and responsibly. Certification requirements will apply to the marketing methodologies of all sponsoring associations and their affiliates.

Actions that could lead to certification revocation:

- Instructing prospective employers to provide false information on forms
- Claiming the sponsoring association, affiliation or representative is endorsed by the BWC
- Offering discounts or refunds that are unattainable

**The Lake County Safety Council is offering special training sessions in October**

The first program, “Accident Investigation Training” on Tuesday, October 6 from 8 to 11:30 a.m., will be held at the Lake County Department of Utilities Learning and Business Center. Registration and pre-payment are required. The cost is \$250 for members and \$280 for non-members. Attendees will learn to conduct a thorough accident investigation, determine root causes of accidents, develop corrective actions and reduce accident rates and expenses. There will be a second technical training class offering that day, in the afternoon. That session will be “Hazard Recognition.” It discusses the top 100 OSHA standards violations. It is designed for safety director, safety committee members, management and maintenance. Details about the session will be distributed soon.
